Learning by Doing - thoughts mostly about learning

emphasis is on practical teaching and learning methods for implementing learning by doing 'Learning by doing', and the term 'experiential learning', are commonly used to refer to several different aspects of learning This guide is not concerned with the assessment of 'prior learning': learning experiences which have taken place before
