Social Control Theory: contends that most people are law-abiding citizens because the desire to fit into the group encourages conformity with the norms Why do some people become deviant while others conform? Social Control Theory suggests that deviance is to be expected unless a person has an investment in the existing social system

**Lemert, Edwin M.: Primary and Secondary Deviance**
